







From the Pastor's Desk....

Dear Parishioners,

On the 61st World Day of Prayer for Vocations, observed on Good Shepherd Sunday, we are invited to pray for and promote all vocations. All Christians need assistance in discerning and responding to the needs of the present-day world through a vocation (calling) that God inspires in them. To participate in the Church's mission is the responsibility of all the baptized. Each member of Christ's Body serves some particular role to build up the whole body. Jesus, the Good Shepherd, is a model for all vocations, particularly for parents and priests. A new CARA survey of the 475 men to be ordained this year in the US points to the overwhelmingly positive influence that parents have had on these men in guiding and supporting their vocations to the priesthood. I attended two priest funerals this week. We now have about 225 active priests in our diocese. I can remember when we had that many parishes and each one had 3-4 priests. We still have nearly that many churches but through mergers we are down to 178 parishes. The numbers indicate that besides a pastor, only the largest parishes (OLBS would be a Medium Size) could have a second diocesan priest to serve as a Parochial Vicar (the term for an associate priest.) About 40% of parishes benefit from the services of a non-incardinated priest, that is, belonging to another diocese or religious order. Of those I mentioned to be ordained this year the average age is 35 and most have been working for several years in teaching, business or other professions. That would suggest our prayers, guidance and support of priestly vocations must extend beyond young people. While parents will play an essential role, all the members of Christ's body are needed. Pray also for vocations to the consecrated life (religious priests, brothers and sisters). I've run out of space to say more, but their witness and charisms are desperately needed today as well. The Good Shepherd will guide us to verdant pastures and life-giving streams.



On April 16th, our students preparing to receive First Holy Communion celebrated a Bread Day Retreat. It was a special time that they spent in Church learning about the celebration of the Mass. We compared how we celebrate milestones and holidays in our home to Sunday Mass. The children realized that food is the main part of both celebrations. They all had the opportunity to see the inside of the Tabernacle, and go into the Sanctuary and stand around the Altar. They were able to taste the unconsecrated host and they are all very excited to receive Jesus on May 4th. We discussed the miracle of how the priest turns the bread and wine into Jesus' body and blood and about the Real Presence. They came to learn what the word consecration means and to pay special attention when the Altar Servers ring the bell during Mass. The students received individual loaves of bread that were sent home to be shared with their families. The purpose of this day is to help them understand that Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist and their lives will be changed forever when they receive Jesus for the first time. 
